

Capita ESS Bett 2018 Twitter 'Education Exists to...' terms and conditions.

1. The Promoter

The Promoter is: Capita Business Services Limited (trading as Education Software Solutions) of 71 Victoria Street, Westminster, London, SW1H 0XA.

2. The competition

2.1 The title of the competition is "Capita ESS Bett 2018: Education Exists to..."

2.2 In order to enter the competition entrants must compose and publish one tweet via the social media channel Twitter, completing the sentence: "Education Exists to..." and containing the hashtag: #EducationExiststo...".

3. How to enter

3.4 The Promoter will not accept responsibility for competition entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind.

3.5 By submitting a competition entry, entrants are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

3.6 The winning entry will be chosen at random by a member of staff of Capita Education Software Solutions whose decision will be final.

3.7 No purchase necessary.

6.2 The decision of the Promoter is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

7. Claiming the prize

7.1 The Promoter will contact the winner via Twitter in order to organise redemption of the prize. The prize can only be delivered to a UK address.

7.2 The prize may not be claimed by a third party.

7.3 The Promoter will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winner, but the Promoter does not accept any responsibility if the winner is not able to take up the prize for whatever reason.

7.4 The prize must be redeemed by 31st March 2018. If it is not redeemed by this date then the Promoter reserves the right to offer the prize to another entrant.

8. Limitation of liability.

Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, or that of its employees. Statutory rights are not affected.

9. Data protection and publicity

9.1 By entering this competition, the entrant agrees that the Promoter may use his or her tweet and the name of winner of this competition for any reasonable and related promotional purposes.

10. General
